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Air Conditioning

The heating & A/C is set on a program and should not require much adjustment. If you desire to change the temperature, all you need to do is adjust the red (heat) or blue (A/C) arrows up or down. Please do NOT lower the A/C below 70 as it may freeze the unit and stop it from working. If you feel the unit is not functioning, please contact Robert Judy from our management company at 843-214-3929.

Alligators

Dishwasher



Make sure dishwasher is ON. Touch the on/off (1) until you see the display light up. Touch 'Normal' (2) to select the wash type. Press 'Start' (3) and then shut within 4 sec. You should see a red light shining on the floor to indicate the dishwasher is running. If you need to open the dishwasher after starting, just press the start button again before closing to resume. If you need to reset the dishwasher, press and hold the 'Start' button for 3 seconds.

Fans

There are ceiling fans in all the bedrooms, living room, and screened porch. The fans in the master bedroom and the twin bedroom are operated via remote that is mounted on the wall. The wall switch must be in the UP position for the remote to work.

Gas Grill

Gas grill is in the garage. Please roll the grill into the driveway at least 10' from the door. The grill must NOT be used from inside the garage. Please remember to roll the grill back into the garage before retiring for the evening. Leaving the grill out all night may leave it open to theft and/or damage. There should be an extra propane tank available if you run out of propane during your stay. Take care to change the tank if that happens and please leave a note on the empty tank and let property manager know.

To start the grill, make sure the propane tank is on by opening the door under the grill and turning the valve counter clockwise all the way. Turn the left burner dial to start (9 o'clock position) and push the black start button. Adjust other burner dials as needed.

To shut off the grill, turn all burner dials to off (12 o'clock position) and make sure the propane tank is off by turning the valve clockwise all the way.

Please use the supplied brush to clean the grill after using. There will be an extra \$25 fee if grill is not cleaned.

Gate Access

Upon arrival at the main gate, you should already have a reservation for your stay and will receive a pass for your car. Please leave this on the dashboard of your car while you are in Wild Dunes. Please contact the property manager if you need access for more than one vehicle.


